Psychiatric Nurse Practitioner

The Angel Harvey Family Health Center Infant Welfare Society of Chicago (IWS), a comprehensive, community-based health center in Chicago's Logan Square neighborhood, is seeking a Contractual Psychiatric Nurse Practitioner to join its Family Services Team.

Position Responsibilities

- Provide child and adolescent psychiatric services for all children and families, including DCFS and managed care referrals as scheduled
- Provide child and adolescent psychiatric services for all children ages 3-18 including psychiatric evaluations, diagnosis, treatment planning, risk assessments and medication management
- Works collaboratively with therapists of the Child and Adolescent Counseling Services program, meets with counseling team every 6 weeks for case consultation
- Conduct clinical/program consultation as scheduled
- Provide at least one evening clinic session per week
- Provide all psychiatric evaluations and treatment in strict accordance with approved methods and practices of the American Medical Association and the American Psychiatric Association

Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities

- Active licensure in the State of Illinois as an APN
- Board Certified by ANCC as a Psychiatric Mental Health Nurse Practitioner (PMHNP-BC) with experience in Child and Adolescent Mental Health, OR Board Certified by PNCB as a Pediatric Primary Care Mental Health Specialist
- Computer skills and experience with electronic medical records
- Proficiency in Spanish is preferred, but not required
