Provide ongoing integrated case management to active clients and monitor the ongoing delivery of CHAT services, including therapeutic/support service for children and their families. Develop curriculum and programming for support groups, trainings, and workshops, and serve as the lead therapist in the facilitation of support groups. Analyze and evaluate the effectiveness of the program and develop new methods aimed at greater success.
