DEAR FRIENDS:

Children and families are at the heart of IWS. The extraordinary legacy of this organization is rooted in providing the very best health care to those in need.

A hallmark of this organization's history is the legacy of innovation that inspires us to offer the unique and cutting-edge services that our patients need. Since 1924, IWS has incorporated child development and behavioral health counseling into its primary care model, and since 1970, provided pediatric dentistry services to low-income children. Orthodontic care was introduced in 1991 and pediatric optometry in 1995. In 2015, the Child-Centered Health and Advanced Therapies (CHAT) Center, launched to provide speech and occupational therapies for children at risk for developmental delays.

Despite the necessity of all of these programs, the cost of service is higher than the reimbursement rates and private dollars must be raised to bridge that gap. In order to preserve our legacy and prepare for the future, the IWS Board of Directors launched the Campaign for a Healthy Tomorrow, a multiyear fundraising initiative. Gifts to the Campaign are permanent investment in the future of our community and in the lives of the children and families we serve.

LIVING Our LEGACY

In 1911, the Infant Welfare Society of Chicago focused its efforts on nourishing babies and reducing infant mortality rates. Today, we are **LIVING** Our **LEGACY**, by proudly offering CenteringPregnancy®, a group model of prenatal care.

The Centering program brings together groups of women with similar due dates to "circle-up" and discuss important topics, including current or expected discomforts, stress and anxiety, proper nutrition, labor and delivery, and breastfeeding.

The program exceeds the recommended standard of 10 prenatal visits by extending the sessions from an hour and a half to two hours in length. During that time, moms engage in their care through group discussions, recording their own vitals, healthy snacks, and time for a private belly check with their provider.

Centering has shown to have positive outcomes for women who participate, including higher birth weights, lower rates of preterm delivery, and more initiation of breastfeeding at birth. Centering care also increases patient and provider satisfaction and provides a sense of community for moms, some of whom are isolated and overwhelmed.

Patients love the group model of care that supports the physical and emotional needs of expecting mothers.

Expectant moms were asked what they would tell other women about getting their prenatal care through the Centering model. Here is what they had to say:

"This program really helps you learn and hear other opinions"

"This is the best way to learn and it helps you a lot"

AUXILIARY Message

The Auxiliary's legacy lives in its tireless commitment of support for the patients and staff of the Angel Harvey Family Health Center and the friendships that have been created along the way. Our 600 loyal members are proud to live this legacy that began in 1913 when a small group of women identified the need for financial resources and volunteers to support the newly established Infant Welfare Society of Chicago.

LEGACY OF FINANCIAL SUPPORT

When the Auxiliary was founded 105 years ago, its initial annual contribution was \$1,591. Today, 10 chapters build on this legacy by hosting a variety of unique fundraisers in their respective communities. Thanks to the dedication of our members and the generosity of our donors, the Auxiliary contributed \$650,000 in direct support to IWS in FY2018. The Auxiliary also made a significant donation of \$20,000 to assist in the Center's purchase of a digital dental x-ray machine.

One reason for the success of our fundraising efforts is the ongoing connection our chapters have with businesses in their communities. From contributions to raffle and silent auctions to cash donations to materials for our events, these businesses support us in a very meaningful way.

LEGACY OF PATIENT COMMITMENT

Throughout our history, the Auxiliary has attached great importance to patient-focused initiatives. Our "See Santa" party attracted more than 300 children this past December, and each child visited with Santa and received a gift purchased and assembled by our members. Throughout the year, our members organized the purchase and distribution of new books, bean soup kits, Mother's Day bags, dental kits, baby clothes, diapers and formula, and supported other programs specifically designed to fit the needs of our patients' families.

LEGACY OF PARTNERSHIP

Over the past several years, our association with CD One Price Cleaners has helped us obtain thousands of winter coats for distribution to patients in need through our Annual Coat Drive. In addition to used coats donated by CD One Price customers and cleaned at no charge, our members donated a considerable number of new coats and

warm weather accessories. As a result of this generosity, we distributed 800 coats and hundreds of new hats and gloves during our Coat Drive in November.

The Center's staff is remarkable and certainly one of its greatest assets. Last summer, the Auxiliary recognized their efforts at a Staff Appreciation Luncheon. This event gave us the opportunity to celebrate our friendships and thank the staff for the dedication they show each day.

LEGACY OF SERVICE

Auxiliary members develop their own personal legacies every occasion they volunteer their time and talent to our organization. Many members serve in leadership roles within their chapters and on the Auxiliary Board. Additionally, several of our members serve on the IWS Board of Directors, allowing them to share their wideranging experience and expertise to make an impact in a broad way. But the strength of our collective contribution comes from the myriad acts of generosity from each of our members throughout Chicagoland.

The Auxiliary is proud of our 105-year partnership with the Angel Harvey Family Health Center; working together to provide quality services to the families of the Center and fostering strong relationships in our communities. We look forward to building on this legacy for many years to come.
